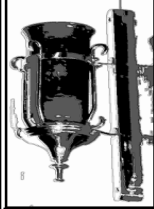

Gaulin, Bonnie Sisk and Blake Conrad.</p> <p>SOCIAL OUTREACH NETWORK UPDATE: <u>AWAKENING THE SLEEPING GIANT</u> Social Outreach was recognized as among the most important ministries to St. Paul's parishioners in our 2014 Ministry Site Profile and continues to receive generous support for its projects. However, the current list of active SON projects does not fully reflect the broad congregational enthusiasm for this ministry. Indeed, Pr. Gerry, the pastoral lead for Social Outreach, accurately described St. Paul's as a 'sleeping giant' with respect to its potential to advance this ministry. Our goal for 2016 is to determine how to 'awaken' this giant and expand the ways that St. Paul's serves those in need at the local, national and global levels. As a first step in this direction, a recent SON meeting brought together Pr. Gerry's fresh perspective and outreach experience with the input and new ideas of eleven parishioners to brainstorm about SON direction and participation. Areas identified to enhance SON involvement and projects included: increasing communication of outreach opportunities, exploring new areas of need to expand project diversity and collaborating with other ministries in joint outreach projects. The success of these and other ideas to awaken the 'sleeping giant' will occur one small step at a time but cannot happen without help from the full St. Paul's community. Please consider bringing your ideas- small or large, recurring or one-time- to our team. You will enjoy the fellowship of this rewarding ministry.</p>
