

Conversation thread has united over 1000 volunteers citywide who are directing diverse projects as part of Giving Tuesday on November 29. As part of this effort, St. Paul's has partnered with a group who is collecting toiletries, mittens/gloves, hats, scarves and blankets for disadvantaged Baltimore citizens. Turkey Dinner Results

The Farm To Table Turkey Dinner held on November 12th was a fund-raising event for the needed Replacement of the Front Doors. Special thanks for the donations of the Turkey's from the Iager's Maple Lawn Farm and the Sides, Vegetables, Ice Cream and Pies from Heyser Farms which made the event financially a huge success. Ticket Sales totaled \$1,243.00 and the Freewill Offering was \$344.00 for a total of \$1,587.00. The miscellaneous expenses of \$276.00 was offset by seed money from Thrivent Financial of \$250.00 for a net expense of only \$26.00 bringing the net results to \$1,561 for the Front Door Replacement Fund. There were 94 adults and 11 children under 12 attending for a total of 105.


