Lent is Coming!

Lent begins on March 1st. Since this year marks the 500th anniversary of the Reformation, along with people throughout the ELCA, we will be spending time studying Martin Luther's Small Catechism.

Prior to Lent, the book *Free Indeed: Devotions for Lent 2017* will be available for each family to take home and use for individual and family devotions time.

On Wednesdays, beginning on March 8, we will gather at 6:00pm for soup and salad (sign ups for bringing food will be up in February).

Around 6:15pm we will transition into study time where each week we will look at a hymn written by Martin Luther based on a section of the Catechism. (The weekly hymns and topics will be announced soon)!

At 7:00pm we will move into the sanctuary for Holden Evening Prayer, a new (to us) setting of evening prayer!

Please plan to join us for all or part of each Wednesday evening during Lent as we journey together through the Catechism and toward Holy Week and Easter!

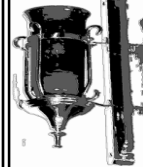
